The objective of the Bible curriculum for kindergarten is to present the Bible characters as real people with real experiences and decisions to face.

Our goal for each child is to know the following from each Bible story:

1. The main characters
2. What they did in the story
3. Why is that important to learn
4. How can I use this story in my daily life
5. The memory verse for that story

The children hear the Bible story presented in a variety of ways over the week. We reinforce the story with role play and various paper/pencil activities and crafts to help each student make the story "his" own. We refer to stories previously taught, when appropriate, to help the children make decisions about their behavior and social skills.
