4. **condescending** - dealing with a person as though he or she were inferior
5. **condone** - to overlook, forgive, or disregard (an offense) without protest; to forgive
6. **denote** - to serve as a mark, symbol, or indication of
7. **despondently** - in a way that shows great sadness
8. **flaunt** - to display oneself to public notice; to show oneself off; to parade around shamelessly
9. **furrowed** - having long trenches or ditches; a narrow groove; wrinkle
10. **immobilized** - unable to move
11. **insolently** - in a way that is insulting or rude

12. **interminable** - endless
13. **muffle** - to wrap or pad in order to deaden the sound of something
14. **obnoxious** - offensive; very annoying or objectionable
15. **persnickety** - very particular about details of little worth or importance
16. **placid** - undisturbed; peaceful; tranquil; serene; calm
17. **premature** - occurring, growing, or existing before the assigned time
