

***B. Specific:***

1. Each student will be expected to participate in a wide range of class activities and enrichment seminars. This includes work with monologues, sonnets, improvisations and specific scenes. (40%)
2. Each student will be encouraged to keep an acting journal during each semester. In this diary the actor should record his/her daily dramatic activities and their feelings and reactions. It should also include your feelings about significant artists and theatrical events. (10%)
3. Each student will be expected to develop his/her part in a class production. The production will be performed at the end of each semester as a part of their final grade. The students will be asked to provide their own costume and makeup as part of the preparation for performance. Their character development should demonstrate the student's continued growth in the dramatic arts. (50%)
