In order for a Website to score in the excellent range, your topic must have strong educational value and a set of objectives that other students find compelling.

Consider these questions when choosing a topic:

- Does the topic of the site cover important issues for students in their school activities or in their lives?
- Is the purpose of the site below or above the level of those using it?
- Is the information on the site appropriate for the age level or others for which the site is intended?
- Is the site fairly educational and useful in giving you knowledge if you weren't already familiar with the subject matter?
- Can the site be used to help you better understand something you might be learning about in school if you were studying the specific topic?
- Is the site helpful in understanding the topic better?
- Can you learn from it easily?
- Does it keep you interested in learning more about the subject matter?
